

THE VARPSUND RUNESTONE

There are about 30 runestones in Håbo. The inscriptions tell the stories of important people who have died, military conquests, and other meaningful events.

The Varpsund Runestone is one of the stones raised to the memory of men who died during expeditions led by Ingvar the Far-Travelled. The expeditions took place between 1036 and 1041 and are the events mentioned on the greatest number of runestones in Sweden. There are 25–30 stones in southern Sweden, collectively called the Ingvar Runestones.
